Sir:-

Referring to your letter No. 254038-44, it was presumed from the writer's conversation with Mr. Scott some weeks ago that payment of the account in question would be made immediately, as we had agreed upon a basis of settlement. I presume the original account is still with Mr. W. J. McLean, to whom it would have been rendered by our Winnipeg Office for certification. I have written instructing our Winnipeg Office to request Mr. McLean to certify it after making a deduction of \$50 as agreed with Mr. Scott, but without any notification from your Department it is possible that he will still refuse to certify the account. In order therefore that no further time may be lost, and that it may be possible to have the account paid from the funds of 1917-18, I would ask you to be so good as to notify Mr. W. J. McLean that the account, amounting to \$1962, can be certified as correct.
