
Dear Mr. Calvert-

Regarding the question of issue of Location Ticket to Daniel Albert for the Northerly 33 acres of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No 1, Range 5, South of the Longwoods Road, Caradoc, I beg to say that the proceedings of the Chippewa Council, of the 24th February last, and of the subsequent meeting, have not as yet been reported to the Department by the local Agent.

I am, however, this day writing the Agent in the matter, and when his report is received, the question of issue of Location Ticket will receive immediate attention.
