With reference to your letter of the 2nd inst.,

I have to say that if the council of the village of Maniwaki is legally constituted and has the power to close
or open streets in the village of Maniwaki, this Department
is willing to open Champagns street and close Basagna street
as requested. It is, however, to be noted that the value
placed on lot I3I South Otjick street is \$85.00 and the
value on lot I36 North Pasagna street is \$90.00, whereas,
the the value of a portion of Pasagna street given in exchange
is only \$87.50 being the mediumbetween the values of the
two adjacent lots I50 and I5I. The municipality will,
therefore, require to pay the difference to the Department
amounting to\$87.50.
