Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 2nd inst., I have to say that if the Council of the village of Maniwaki is legally constituted and has the power to close or open streets in the village of Maniwaki, this Department is willing to open Champagne street and close Pasagna street as requested. It is, however, to be noted that the value placed on lot 131 South Otjick street is \$85.00 and the value on lot 136 North Pasagna street is \$90.00, whereas, the value of ^{the} portion of Pasagna street ^{to be} given in exchange is only \$87.50 being the ~~mediu~~ ^{medium} between the values of the two adjacent lots 150 and 151. The municipality will, therefore, require to pay the difference to the Department amounting to \$87.50.
