Sir:-

I beg to enclose herewith lists showing how the Indian supplies, to be delivered in the Winnipeg warehouse under contract 1912-1913 should be distributed to the various Agencies and Schools named.

The extra quantity of tea to be delivered should be kept in store for future requirements.

Slight changes have been made in the distribution of rice and soap which increased the quantity and you will please request the contractor to deliver 14,400 lbs of each of these articles instead of the quantities mentioned in the Schedule.

You will see by the list of clothing that the contract for serge, men's trousers and blankets has been increased.

The supplies for Lac la Rouge School should as usual be held for shipment until the beginning of December.

The supplies for the Norway House Agency should be shipped to Mr. Agent Calverley at Norway House, as soon as navigation opens.
