Sir,-

I beg to inform you that a communication has been received from Mrs. Melissa Hill, in regard to application of Mrs. Lucretia Jamieson to obtain the privilege of selling some logs from timber blown down last fall, in which letter she states that you had been asked for a permit, but advised her that she would have to apply to the Council.

If the logs are cut from dead and fallen timber on land of which Mrs. Jamieson has been recognized as owner unless you know of any objection thereto, there would not appear to be any reason why she might not be given a permit to sell what lumber may not be required in repairing her house.
