Cross-Examined by the Accused.

Q.1 How did you discover it was my handwriting?

A.1 I was in a rush when I gave you the money, but on examining it afterwards it did not look genuine.

Burch to ascertain his account no. with the Bank of Montreal. I found that the cheque, Exhibit "A", bore the account no. of Capt. Burch's account. I reported this fact to L/Sgt. Hickman.

The Accused declined to cross-examine the witness.

"I am a L/Edr. of the 6 Cdn. Fd. Regt. R.C.A.
The accused approached me one evening in the early part of July, 42, and asked me if I would be going to Hersham the following morning. He told me that he had a cheque that he had received from his wife in the amount of £11-0-0 and asked me to present it at the bank to be cashed. I asked him if he had the cheque with him, and he replied that it was back in his tent and he would either give it to me that evening or the next morning, before I left for Town.

I did not see the accused the following but I was given an envelope by Gnr. Marsh, D., in which were enclosed two letters now produced and marked Exhibits "E" & "F". I never received any cheque from the accused.

The Accused declined to cross-examine the witness.
