

Summary of Evidence in the case of K 52379 ^{3/c}

First Witness

K 52267 Sergeant Roberts T. The Seaforth Highlanders
of Canada, having been duly sworn states:

Sir
I am platoon sergeant of "B" platoon D Company
~~and have been so since 2nd November 1942~~
when it was reported to me by Hqpt
Ohling who is the N.C.O. in charge of the
accused's billet that the accused had been
absent from quarters from 2300 hours 1st
November 1942. I did not see the accused
until after he was returned to the unit
by Canadian Provost Corps. Sir

Sgt. Thos Roberts.

The accused declines to cross examine this
witness.

Second Witness

K 52685. Hqpt Ohling. O.C. The Seaforth Highlanders
of Canada, having been duly sworn states:

Sir
on the 1st November 1942 I was N.C.O. in charge
of the billet where Pte Power J.B. sleeps. At
approximately 2300 hours 1st November 1942 I made
a personal check of all beds in the billet
and found the accused to be absent.
I reported the accused's absence to the platoon
sergeant, Sgt Roberts T. at 0730 hours 2nd November 1942
