Crew to be carried - Two (2) pilots @ 170 lbs. each - 340 lbs. Carrying capacity (full tanks gasoline and oil & weight of crew) - 3,701 lbs. Number of passengers allowed - Twenty-eight (28) Equipped for Night Flying.
