This Quarter's Lessons

A general pre-view of the lessons is of great help to parents and teachers. This column is for them-not for the little onesexcept the table with which it closes, which the children should learn by heart, one title each Sabbath, repeating also Sabbath by Sabbath those already memorized.

Our good old Shorter Catechism sums up all Christ's "offices" as our Redeemer in these three-that of a Prophet, of a Priest and of a King. We have already seen Him as a Prophet or Teacher, and many of His discourses are still to be studied. When we come to the closing days of His earthly ministry, we shall discover more as to His priestly office-how He intercedes with God for men, and how He gave Himself as the great sacrifice for the sin of the world.

This Quarter Christ is chiefly before us as a King. He tells us of what sort His kingdom is, how strangely different from the kingdoms of this world, and how much greater and more abiding than they. He shows who are and who are not members of His kingdom, what its laws are, and in what ways it may be extended. We have samples of the King's wrath and pity. We see Him scorned and honored, and we witness the sending forth of the first messengers of the kingdom.
