

in their discretion think necessary, to work after such manner as they the said Surveyors shall direct, in providing materials as aforesaid, and the number of hours which any person shall work as aforesaid, shall be deducted from, and allowed as a part of the number of hours he is obliged by Law to work on the Highways, and any person or persons not attending, or refusing to work, when summoned as aforesaid, shall forfeit the sum of four shillings for each day's neglect; and that all persons keeping any Waggon, Carts, Trucks, Sleds or Teams, shall, when called upon by such Surveyor, for the purposes aforesaid, attend with the same in the manner directed in and by the tenth section of the above recited Act, and subject to the same penalties and forfeitures for neglecting and refusing to attend as in and by the said Section is provided.

III. *And be it further enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the Surveyors of Highways in the several Parishes in this Province when so directed by the Commissioners, to summon the Inhabitants thereof, to perform their several proportions of Labour on the Highways in the most fit and suitable time between the first day of May and the first day of September, in each and every year, and shall proceed to expend the Labour on the Roads and Highways in the manner directed by the eighth Section of the Act to which this is an amendment, subject nevertheless to such orders and directions as they may from time to time receive from the Commissioners; and the said Surveyors are hereby

Surveyors when ordered by the Commissioners to summon Inhabitants to work between the first of May and first of September.
