Act of Upper-Canada, 37. Geo. III. and appointed, and the Commissioners nominated and appointed; on behalf of the Province of Upper Canada, under Authority of An Act passed by the Legislature of that Province, in the thirty seventh year of Your Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to authorise the Lieutenant Governor to nominate and appoint certain Commissioners for the "purposes therein named;" which Additional Articles follow:

Upper-Canada may ratify the Provisional Agreement, fulpend the certain conditions the operation of the 6th Article. ARTICLE I. "That the Legislature of the Province of Upper Canada, may fatify the aforesaid Provisional Agreement, with a condition, suspending the operation and execution of the fixth Article thereof, so long as the Government of the United States of America does not levy Duties on Goods Wares and Merchandizes passing from the Province of Upper-Canada, into the Territory of the said States."

Upper-Canada allowed a just procortion of the Daties imposed by Lower Canada.

ART. II. "That the Legislature of the Province of Lower Canada, will allow and pay to the Province of Upper-Canada, such just proportion of the Duties imposed and levied by the Legislature of Lower Canada as the aforesaid Province of Upper-Canada would have had a right to Claim, if the aforesaid Articles of Agreement had been ratisfied and confirmed, by the Legislature of the Province of Upper-Canada."

Continuance of this Agreement, ART. III. "That this agreement shall continue and be in force until the first day of March, in the Year one thousand eight hundred and one, and no longer.

Additional Articles of Agreement ratified and approved. May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by Virtue of, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of An Act passed in the sourteenth Year of His Majesty's "Reign, intituled "An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North-America, and to make surther Provision for the Government of the said Pravince." And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that all and every the said Additional Articles of Agreement herein before mentioned and inferted, shall be and the same are hereby ratisfied, approved and confirmed.

Not to be binding on Upper-Canada, until confirmed by the Legislature of t at Province.

II. Provided always, and be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that neither the before mentioned Articles of Agreement, made on the twenty eighth day of January, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, nor the Additional Articles of Agreement in this Act mentioned and inserted, shall be binding or obligatory on this Province, towards the Province of Upper Canada, until the Articles of Agreement made on the twenty eighth day of January as aforesaid, shall be ratified, approved and confirmed by the Legislature of the Province of Upper Canada, subject to the alterations and modifications stated and set forth in the Additional Articles of Agreement, made on the eleventh day of February, herein before mentioned.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall continue to be in force to the first day of March, in the Year one thousand eight hundred and one, and no longer.
