Mr. J. Elliot Smith, of Wolfville, has received the following letter from an apple agent in London, which will be of interest to Nova Scotia fruit growers:

At some late meeting of the F. G. A., I noted the subject of a Standard barrel and taking under Government inspection had an airing. There is room for another barrel on packing.

Passing down Shaft-bury Avenue this p.m., I was attracted by a newly opened barrel of Baldwins, and seeing it was a N. S. six-booped ordinary barrel, I stepped in and asked permission to dig down into the barrel. The top layer was a fairly good No. 1. Immediately beneath came No. 2, and further down came inferior 3's, small, green and bell-shaped. Seventeen shillings was paid for the barrel. The barrel was branded No. 1 Baldwins. (L. J. A.) W. CHAPACIER COUNTS

"Let a man tell you his story every morning and evening," said a famous Englishman in characterizing the newspapers, "and at the end of a twelvemonth he will have become your master." What if the man is brazen faced, a chronic liar, one who rejoices in iniquity, and is utterly reckless in principle, who is thus welcomed daily to the home circle? Ought not a newspaper that is indifferent to truth, is self-seeking and has no regard for individual rights or for public morals, to be treated as you would deal with a scoundrel who seeks admission to your home and company? Let an unprincipled journalist tell you its daily story, why an inexorable moral law you will in due time have an "evil spirit" for your master.

In the same connection we are reminded of an interesting lecture by an old journalist and member of Parliament, Mr. R. L. Richardson, of Winnipeg. "Character," said he, is just as essential for a newspaper as it is for a man who is dependent upon the public for support. It is therefore of as prime importance that an editor should guard the reputation and character of his newspaper as it is that an individual should guard his own reputation and character. If honesty is the best policy for an individual, it is, in an accentuated degree, the best policy for a newspaper. In a peculiar sense a newspaper belonging to the public, being in reality the creation of the public. In the lecturer's mind the best example of the value of preserving character in a newspaper is the history of the Montreal Witness, which the speaker regarded as perhaps the most influential journal in Canada
