The attendance of farmers and gardeners was very good, with an active demand.

As usual, the bulk of grain receipts were oats, which sold freely from \$1.20 to \$1.25.

A few bags of barley sold at \$1.15.

A few loads of wheat offered \$1.25. No rye or buckwheat offered.

Feeding peas, \$1.10 per cental; seed peas, 75c to 85c per bu.

Hay in good supply, at \$7.00 to \$8.50 per ton.

HAY AND SEEDS.

Hay and straw—Only ten loads of hay on sale at \$8.50 to \$9.00 per ton. Sales were slow owing to the quantity offered during the week. Messrs. McCortney and Tumbler are shipping over 200 horses today, and will not require a very large quantity for some time.

Butter and Eggs—Butter was in fair supply at prices unchanged at 13c to 14c for crocks and 22c to 23c for pound rolls.

Eggs were plentiful, selling in crate lots at 10c to 10.5c, and 11c per dozen by the basket; 12c was paid for the single dozen.

Apples—Were more plentiful than for some time; owing to the high prices asked sales are slow at \$1.50 to \$1.75 per bag, and \$3 to \$3.50 per barrel for choice stock.

Vegetables and Roots—More potatoes were offered today than on any one day since the heavy offerings last fall; 75c per bag was asked at the opening of the market; 60c and 65c per bag was most frequently paid later in the day. Green onions sold at 25c per dozen; radishes, 2c to 3c; rhubarb was scarce at 90c to \$1 per dozen.

Poultry—Was scarce with prices firm, especially for chickens, which sold at 60c to 80c per pair for dressed; 45c to 60c per pair for live ones; a large number of turkeys sold at 11c to 12c per lb., the last named price was paid for hen turkeys.

Dressed Hogs—Not many offered; there was a good demand at \$7.75 to \$8 per cwt.; only a few reached the latter figures.

Maple Syrup—Was plentiful at \$1 to \$1.10 per gallon.

Live Hogs—Mr. D. McIntyre will pay \$6 per cwt. on Monday for selecta. This is an advance of 15c per cwt. over last Monday. Small pigs sold at \$4.50 to \$5 per pair, according to size.

Meats—Plentiful, with no change in price.
