DRUNKENNESS SHOULD BE TREATED AS A DISEASE

AMONCTON, Mar. 10.—Some interesting suggestion for treatment of criminals were advanced by Dr. O. J. MacCall, formerly of St. John, in a lecture held on Sunday afternoon on the treatment of criminals. Dr. MacCall advocated treatment of the same as for physical infirmities and opposed the present court and prison system. He favored the police taking drunks home instead of arresting them, and also against the present system of medical expert testimony in courts and the indiscriminate sentencing of convicts in prisons.
