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ALFONSO'S SUDDEN AND ALARMING ILLNESS.

History of His Majesty's sickness—His illness—The gravest apprehensions.

LONDON, Nov. 24.—It is reported here this evening that the King of Spain is dead. Nothing whatever can be learned from Madrid to confirm or deny the report, but the fact that stocks declined 7 per cent in that city to-day is taken in some quarters to indicate that something of an alarming character at least has happened to his majesty.

King Alfonso first showed some signs of catarrhal fever in the spring last year, and during four weeks was ill but not a single day was he ill. In the summer of 1884 he took the waters of Baden, in the Baden province, which was a complete success that he passed a good winter and resumed his active life and habits of hunting, shooting and riding.

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
