(2)—The Army List for July, 1851.

(3)—A list published in the "United Service Magazine" (1849, parts 2 and 3.)

The names of the recipients of "Gold Medals" are taken from Sir H. Nicholas' "History of the Orders of British Knighthood."

The list of the Regimental Officers of the Regular Army were, for various reasons, withdrawn; the present printed material being substituted.
