## CHICAGO MARKET—January 2, 1900

**NEW YEAR OPENS WITH VERY STRONG MARKETS. PROVISIONS ESPECIALLY STRONG. MARKETS ABROAD WERE ALSO VIGOROUS.**

Chicago, Jan. 2.

March and May wheat at Liverpool opened 1/2 higher at 5-11 1/2 and 5-10 1/2. Later cables gave wheat as being unchanged and corn 1/2 higher, both being firm. Shipments announced as 4,696,000 and stocks in Liverpool 1,839,000 cents 1/4.

New York markets opened from 1/2 to 3/4 higher for May wheat at 75 3/4, 1/4 and 3/4 higher at 75 1/2 for July wheat. September wheat was also traded in on the basis of 76 1/2.

Chicago openings showed January wheat with 3/4 advance at 66 1/2; May 1/2 advance and July from 1/2 to 1/4 advance. January corn was unchanged, July 1/4 advance, and May 1/2 advance. May oats opened 1-16 higher;

In Chicago provision markets January and May pork opened 15 cents higher. January and May lard 7 cents higher; and ribs, January, at 20 cents advance, and May 18 to 23 cents advance.

While the grain market was not very active there was up till noon a decided upward tendency, confined not to any particular grain or option of grain, but being a feature of the whole market. Strength was even more pronounced in the provision markets to-day, where the movements were working to higher level. The May option in all being the most active, having gained in pork 15 cents at the opening.

Provision receipts to-day—Hogs, 20,000; cat's, 8,500; sheep, 17,000.

At Kansas—Hogs, 3,700; cattle, 3,000; and at Omaha—Hogs, 5,000.
