THE GLASGOW MARKET.

Messrs. Allison, Cousland & Co., in their last monthly timber market report, say: There has been little improvement in business during the past month. Imports have been heavy, and in some items have been much overdone. Good pine, however, is scarce and should sell well, but the standard of quality generally is not improving, and consequently prices are very unsettled. Shipbuilding continues brisk, but other industries are not too well employed.

YELLOW PINE—Waney—The import has been light and mostly on contract. Prices rule firm. 19 to 20 inch average is quoted at 3s to 3s 4d per cubic ft. Inferior wood is scarce and good prices are obtained. Square.—There has been a fair demand and prices are good. 1st class, 3s to 40 feet, is quoted at 2s 7d to 2s 9d, G. F. A. wood, 20d to 22d per cu. ft.

RED PINE—The stock is ample and little business has been done.

ELM—Business has been brisk and prices keep firm. Quotations—2s 10d to 3s 1d for 45 to 50 feet average. Inferior wood is quoted at 2s to 2s 4d per cu. ft.

OAK—Stocks are small and there has been a good demand. Prices are very firm.

BIRCH—Imports during the month have been light but stocks are heavy and there is little demand. Quotations.—17d to 18d wood.

ASH—Of good size is in fair demand, but small wood is difficult to dispose of except at low figures.

PINE—Imports have been heavy, and the bulk of goods landed has had to be stored. The general quality has been very poor. **FIRSTS**.—Broad are quoted at £24 15s. to £28 17s. 6d. Undersized, £19 18s. 9d. to £21 6s. 9d. Sidings, £17 17s. 6s. to £19 18s. 9d. Boards and strips, £12 7s. 6d. to £16 10s. per St. Pet. Std. **SECONDS**.—Are in little request and stocks are increasing. **QUOTATIONS**.—Regulars and Broad, £16 10s. to £18 11s. 3d. Undersized, £13 1s. 3d. to £15 2s. 6d. **THIRDS**.—Are in moderate demand. Regulars are quoted at £11 13s. 9d. to £13 1s. 3d. **FOURTHS**.—Stocks are small, but sales are limited. Regulars are quoted at £9 12s. 6d. to £10 6s. 3d. Undersized, £8 5s. per St. Pet. Std.

RED PINE—The market is glutted and prices are exceedingly low. **QUOTATIONS**.—£7 4s. 4d. to £10 6s. 3d., according to specification.

SPRUCE—Is in fair request at £6 10s. 7d. to £8 5s. per St. Pet. Std.

N. B. BIRCH.—Stocks are heavy, and ample for present requirements. Prices are little altered from last quotations.

N. B. SPRUCE. Stocks are heavy in many sizes, but a large amount of business is being done and prices are considered to be about the bottom. Quotations.—£6 3s.
