The President, William Rennie, Esq., presided, and in opening the meeting congratulated the members on another prosperous year, notwithstanding, as he said, the musual stringency of the times, which, no doubt, affected to some extent the amount of business, yet the year closed with an increased membership and a greater feeling of security and confidence among the insured in the Company's system of business. We find the average cost of insurance in 1886 (including all ages from 18 to 60 years) to be \$50.00 per \$5.000—this covering "Life Benefits," "Disability Claims" and amount carried to "Reserve." We also find the ratio of expenses of Company to be only \$25.75 to every \$100 paid in claims.

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
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
