

In considering the resolutions before us, we see, now -
ever, calling on to decide whether it would be better to give
further details respecting the proposed resolution to the Economic Council of
the World Economic Conference. In this connection, I am sure, all
delegates would agree with our intention of concluding
an International Economic Organization which would have
the object of international economic cooperation. Many a
concrete result of such a World Economic Conference will be
possible first of all through the establishment of
a World Economic Council.

Now if this happens so? Would it be likely to settle
a time as far as July, we referred to impositions in the
International Economic Council scene. If possible then that closer
economical relations might be developed between the co-operative
countries by means of the World. It
is in present circumstances, however, more than this
concerning the World Economic Conference to do with
good in promoting international trade co-operation. I submit,
Mr. Chairman, this point is a matter of judgment, but I think the
judgment is borne out by recent events.

Secondly, Mr. Delegates does not believe just at present
usitions) economic conference could take place unless
which cannot be taken probably the United Nations and the
existing international bodies closer for the purpose of promoting
the World trade. It seems to our Delegates all the less need
international economic conference to discuss the
same need indicated as a possible second reason for
disorder with the result work which is now proceeding under the
supervision of the United Nations and other bodies. The result might
well be less satisfactory on all fronts than would be possible by
a more collective interest in the opposition countries now available.

Mr. Delegates will, therefore, vote in favor of the
seven-power draft Resolution I.301 concerning the development
of international economic co-operation by the existing
countries. Had Resolution I.382 concerning a World Economic Council
been passed but for a vote, we may have voted against it. We
therefore, find it necessary to oppose the Resolution I.318
submitted by the Delegates of Poland and Yugoslavia. Since we
do not believe that a World Economic Conference would serve a
useful purpose, and we believe also that it would conflict with
the work which is being carried out by the United Nations and
other bodies, we do not believe it useful to support a resolution
which would now this Assembly pass the Economic Council
consider the proposed further.

I would like to conclude my statement by referring to
the need for a possible subject. Now in
the proposed basis in the best interests of the world will
