IN CASE OF FIRE

UPON DISCOVERY OF FIRE

- Leave Fire Area.
- Close Doors Behind You.
- Sound Fire Alarm.
- Do **NOT** Use Elevators.
- Use Nearest Stairway.
- Clear the Building/Minimum 100 Metres.
- Remain Calm.**

UPON HEARING FIRST STAGE ALERT SIGNAL

(Slow Intermittent Signal - 20 beats per minute)

- Listen for instructions over loud-speakers.
- Locate the nearest exit.
- Prepare to evacuate when ordered to do so,
or upon hearing the second stage alarm signal.

UPON HEARING SECOND STAGE ALARM SIGNAL

(Continuous Signal - 120 beats per minute)

- Evacuate immediately using the nearest exit.

CAUTION

Feel door before opening it. If warm, remain in your area. If not, evacuate via nearest exit closing all doors behind you. If smoke is heavy in the corridor, it may be safer to stay in your area. Close door and seal all cracks. Notify Building Fire/Safety Control Centre at **992-1150** or **992-5452** of your location (i.e. Tower, Floor, room number). If you encounter smoke in stairway, use alternate exit.
