Surely the time has come to abandon the perversity of war; to devote our talents and our wills to the immensely harder tasks of peace.

If we in this generation are to make our contribution to the solution of the real problem facing mankind, we must be prepared to abandon many customary ways. Our link in the growing that binds nature to man's needs must be truly welded if those that follow are to meet the problems of their day. It was never more true than it is to-day that

"New times demand new measures and new men, The World advances, and in time outgrows The law that in our fathers' day were best; And doubtless, after us some better scheme Will be shaped out by wiser men than we, Made wiser by the steady growth of truth."
