His Excellency Dr. Conté Saidou today presented his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Guinea to Canada.

The ceremony took place at Government House at 11.00 a.m. Mr. Henry F. Davis, Chief of Protocol, Department of External Affairs, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor General. Mr. John K. Starnes, Acting Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor General were in attendance on the Governor General on this occasion.

Dr. Conté was Ambassador of Guinea in Moscow from September 1960 to March 1961. He was appointed Ambassador in Washington in April of that year where he will continue to reside.
