**Mr. Drew:** May I have an indication as to when the house leader does expect to bring forward the measure relating to resale price maintenance?

Mr. Fournier (Hull): I could not give the definite hour on Monday, but on Monday we intend to bring it up.

Mr. Graydon: You are going on with it?

Mr. Fournier (Hull): Certainly. It was announced in the speech from the throne.
