NATIONAL FILM BOARD DISMISSALS

Question No. 239—Mr. Rouleau:

1. How many employees have been dismissed from the national film board since June 10, 1957? 1957?

2. Among those, how many are technicians, producers, heads of branches?

3. How many employees have been hired since June 10, 1957?

Answer by: Hon. Ellen L. Fairclough (Minister of Citizenship and Immigration):

1. Four.
2. Two junior technicians.
3. From June 10, 1957 to March 6, 1959, 112 persons have been regularly appointed in continuing positions; 39 have been engaged on a term basis and 42 on a contract basis.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, NATIONAL MUSEUM

Question No. 247—Mr. Argue:

What are the duties and responsibilities of the administrative officer of the national museum of Canada?

Answer by: Hon. Alvin Hamilton (Minister of Northern Affairs and National Resources):

Under direction, to have financial control responsibility for the human history and natural history branches of the national museum of Canada, through preparation of annual estimates, commitment control, encumbrances, financial aspects of project control audit and supervision of accounts procedures; to act as adviser to the directors on administrative matters and business management; to have general responsibility for and direct supervision of staff engaged in the administration of the two branches; to prepare correspondence, directives and reports; to advise professional staff on administrative matters and to perform other related duties as required.
