It has occurred to me that in making the appointment of Research Professor in Parasitology and Director of the Institute, it should be made clear that while the duties of the position would involve the direction of a certain amount of graduate work that might be undertaken, the undergraduate work in parasitology would continue as now organized, in association with the work in Entomology and under the general direction of the head of that department. This is the arrangement that we feel will work most satisfactorily and, to avoid any possible misunderstanding, it would seem advisable to have it understood from the outset.
