

Council in *Brazil*; and to trade in  
off there, and to carry Slaves back  
in Return; which Privilege of sail-  
ing with their own Ships from *New*  
*Netherland* to *Brazil*, should be  
exclusively allowed to Patroons and  
Colonists, who promote the Popu-  
lation in *New Netherland*, and not  
to the Interlopers, who only carry  
Goods to and fro, without attending  
to Agriculture. By this Means not  
only would *Brazil* be supplied with  
Provisions at a cheaper Rate, but  
*New Netherland* would by Slave  
Labor, be more extensively culti-  
vated than it has hitherto been.
