

and power to speak the complete mind of every one of the Allied Tribes on all matters, particularly those matters which specially affect them as Individual Tribes. Therefore, if the Governmnets should see fit to enter into negotiations with us, it might become necessary also to enter into negotiations regarding some matters with individual tribes.

We certify that the Statement above set out was adopted at a full meeting of the Executive Committee of the Allied Tribes of British Columbia held at Vancouver on the 12th day of November, 1919, and by the Sub-Committee of the Executive Committee on the 9th day of December in the same year.
