PRINCIPAL EXPORTS.

The principal exports have hitherto been horned cattle, horses, sheep, pork, lard, tallow, butter, cheese, pearl and pot ash, the last of which is manufactured by the Settler in the progress of clearing his land, affording an early return for his labour, and the means of procuring supplies of provisions and necessaries for continuing his improvements.

CHARACTER OF POPULATION.

The present population of the Eastern Townships consists mainly of Emigrants from Great Britain and the United States, speaking the English language, and governed by English laws. Municipal institutions are also in successful operation, whereby the people have the entire control of their own local affairs.
