and that without delay, some permanent and satisfactory objections to the measure from you, I have made up my mind to yield to those importunities, and have the letter printed and sent abroad into the world; where I fancy it will be read with delight by his excellency Governor Cass, & by the freemen in the Michigan Tetritory, whom it appears, you was willing to make vassal slaves at the time that you gave up Fort Detroit.
