- 7. Moses first tended Jethro's sheep, then shepherded the Literal Israel in the wilderness.
- 8. Saviour of his people.
- Rejected at his first attempt. Successful at his second attempt.
- 10. Mediator between **God** and **Israel**, under the Old Covenant.
- 11. God sent Moses to deliver His chosen people.
- 12. Ordained the Passover.
- 13. The law came by Moses.

  - 40 days appeared to His disciples after His resurrection.
