



IV. - Historical Tour of Quebec

I—THE CHATEAU FRONTENAC HOTEL. The first "Fort St. Louis" begun by Champlain, 1620. Held by Kirke for Charles I, 1629-32. The first "Chateau St. Louis", 1647, (old stone in present entrance.) Iroquois war canoes defy French, 1656. Frontenac defies Phips, 1690. Montcalm, Saunders and Wolfe, 1759, (positions visible). Carleton defies Montgomery, 1775. H. R. H. the Duke of Kent at a ball on his birthday, 1791. The Chateau burnt, 1834. The Terrace begun under Lord Durham, in
