It is expected that a meeting between the king and the future queen of Spain, Princess Ena of Battenberg, will occur at the latter city.

## Health of the Capital.

Ottawa, Dec. 29.—There were 1137 deaths in Ottawa this year, 17.6 in every 1000 of the population, exactly the same as 1904, and considerably less than in 1903. There were no epidemic of unusual sicknesses. The civic isolation hospital had seven deaths, as compared with 17 three years ago.

KEEP THAT GONG RINGING  
NEW ORDER TO MOTORMEN

Ring it When Car Starts, When Approaching Standing Car and When Nearing a Crossing.

New regulations to motormen have been issued by the Toronto Street Railway Company, and have been posted for their guidance in the vestibules of the cars.

"Never start a car without a proper signal from the conductor, and then striking the gong."

"Never start a car while passengers are getting on or off the front end of the car."

"When nearing intersections, and following another car, and on any other occasion, when you have once stopped, never start your car without the proper signal. (See rule one)."

"When approaching a car going in the opposite direction of your car, turn the power off your car, and always ring your gong and keep it ringing until you have passed the car."

"When approaching a standing car always ring your gong and turn the power off your car. Approach a standing car slowly, keeping the gong ringing until you have passed the same, and have a sharp lookout for passengers who may attempt to cross the tracks in front of your car from behind the standing car."

"Never attempt to take any intersection when a car from another direction is approaching it. Always wait until the car approaching has come to a standstill before starting your car to cross an intersection."

"When approaching a street crossing, always ring your gong, ringing until you pass the street; also ring the gong loudly whenever necessary to attract attention, and repeat as often as is required."

"Upon all occasions conductors must be absolutely sure that passengers are safely on or off the cars before giving bells to start."

"Motor conductors must never give bells to start without first getting the bells from the trailer conductor; and trailer conductors must always brake the trailer car when approaching an intersection."

"When any accident shall happen as a result of the abuse of these orders, the man responsible will be subject to dismissal."

And Coyotes.

San Antonio, Texas, Dec. 29.—A great loss of domestic animals is being sustained in Northern Mexico by coyotes and wolves with the rabies. Cattlemen from the Rio Grande country say practically all the coyotes beyond the river are mad, and the cattlemen are scouring the country and exterminating them. Several Mexican children in Coahuila have been bitten with fatal results. The spread of rabies to Texas is feared.

Will Be a Catholic.

Roma, Dec. 29.—The Italian who soon is to be married to King Alfonso of Spain, will come to Rome in January, and will be accepted into the Catholic Church at St. Peter's. She will be baptised by Archbishop Storace, the archbishop of Palermo, who is now in Rome, in the presence of Cardinal Merry del Val, the papal secretary of state.

Three Trains Killed.

Huntingdon, Ind., Dec. 29.—By the derailing of an engine and ten cars of a freight train on the Chicago and Erie Railroad, near Altoona, Pa., today, Engineer John J. O'Brien, Fireman C. B. Oliver and brakeman Lemuel Fisher were instantly killed.

Acetylene Gas Explosion.

Greenwich, Conn., Dec. 29.—An acetylene gas tank on the grounds of the country estate of Chas. B. McConnaughey, near the Malabar, Steamship Line at Byram Shore, exploded last night, killing James MacKay, a gardener, employed on the place.

Dr. Drummond's Guest.

UNWORTHY TO BE PRESENTED.

Catholic Bishops Complain of Character of Pope's Catholics.

Rome, Dec. 29.—The Vatican authorities have received remonstrances from several American bishops against the audience granted by the Pope to Americans who, in the opinion of these bishops, were not worthy of the honor, and which, it is added, created dissatisfaction among the faithful.

The Pope has also been informed that among the persons presented to him a few days ago was an American woman who had been divorced. This irritated the Pontiff, who declared that such a presentation must not occur again.

The officials of the Vatican are also recalling that two Americans recently refused to kneel when the Pope appeared, and the persons having authority in these matters have been ordered to be more careful in arriving at decisions upon applications from Americans for audiences of the Pope.

Applicants in future must be recommended by their respective bishops or have their applications supported by a recognized official here.

A Question of Identity.

On Dec. 21, a Syrian, Petrus Saad, was assaulted near Napanee. He was also thought to be the same man who was sent to the hospital at Kingston for repairs. On Wednesday last a man was arrested charged with the assault and robbery.

Last June 20, one Petrus Saad was arrested in Parkdale on the charge of firing a revolver in the street and acting in an insane way. He was sent to St. Michael's Hospital and allowed to go in two weeks. The Toronto police have not seen him since. They have \$13 of his money, and his watch and papers. It is possible that the Napanee man may be the same man. He formerly lived at 19 Washington-street, New York. His right name is supposed to be Samuel Yahua.

Washington, Dec. 29.—As the result of a cave-in, which occurred to-day at the site of the new National Metropolitan Citizens' Bank Building, 460 Broadway, in New York, 10 men were killed and two other workmen injured. Of the latter, C. J. Smith, a carpenter, was the more seriously hurt.

No Work for Snow Shovelers.

Montreal, Dec. 29.—Hundreds of poor men who have depended to a large extent for their livelihood during the winter on clearing snow for the city sent a deputation to the city hall this morning claiming work of some kind to enable them to live.
