Hereafter the hundreds of passengers crossing the ocean on the great liners may be kept in touch with all the happenings of the entire world during every minute of the voyage. They may receive private messages, keep fully posted on the markets, watch the progress of the war, and, in fact, by the use of the wireless system, know all that is going on as fully as tho they were on land. At the same time steam-ship officials and friends of the passengers may keep in perfect touch with the vessel and follow her progress from day to day. In case of impending disaster or accident news can be flashed to land almost in an instant, adwhere possible, measures for relief promptly taken. Mysterious disappear ances of vessels in mid-ocean will be a thing of the past, and relatives on land will have the melancholy satisfaction of knowing the fate of their loved ones in cases where loss cannot be averted.
