**GRAIN FUTURES LOWER  
AT THE CHICAGO MARKET****Liverpool Market Closed—Crop  
Outlook Said to Depress  
the Options.**

Saturday Evening, June 6.

Liverpool grain markets were closed today.

At Chicago, July wheat closed 1/2 lower than Friday, July corn 1/4 lower, and July oats 1/4 lower.

Winnipeg car lots of wheat to-day, 32; car lots, 219.

Chicago car lots to-day: Wheat, 31; corn, 2; oats, 107; 1. Northwest cars to-day, 190; week ago, holiday, year ago, 27.

Through freight rates from Columbia, Tenn., to New York have been advanced 1/2 cent. Weather here and elsewhere late with showing blight. Weather unfavorable for harvesting.

**ST. LAWRENCE MARKET.**

Receipts of farm produce were moderate. 40 bushels of grain, 15 loads of hay, several loads of mixed produce, and poultry on the market.
