Issues.—It affords your Committee much gratification to state, that not only have the large issues of the preceding year been maintained, but that a much larger circulation has been effected, exceeding by many thousands any which it has yet been their privilege to announce. Nor is this increase, as might naturally be conceived, due to the popularity which attaches to the Portions of the New Testament. On the contrary; the increase in the sale of Portions during the year has only amounted to 40,316, whilst the increase in the sale of Bibles has amounted to 45,774; thus proving that the food which the Gospel affords only quickens the appetite for more, and that he who has made himself acquainted with a portion of Scripture Truth, will not rest satisfied until he has become possessed of the whole counsel of God, as revealed in His written Word. The entire circulation has amounted to 2,495,118 copies, being in excess by 361,258 copiesover that of the year preceding. The following table will give a comprehensive view of these issues:—
