FRANK MORAN IS AFTER WILLARD

After Successful Campaign in England He Returns to Win the Heavyweight Honors.

NEW YORK, May 22.—Frank Moran, the big sorrel-topped heavyweight, the idol of Great Britain's boxing fans, because of his recent knockout of Bombardier Wells, is coming to this country for the purpose of battling his way to the heavy-weight championship. He has been secured by the Brighton Beach Sporting Club, which will operate this summer at the Brighton Beach race track, and will be matched with the leading contender for Jess Willard's crown. Should Moran be successful in these contests he will have the first chance at the title in the fall, as Willard has given the Brighton Beach club an option on his services for the first appearance in an actual contest.



Just at present Moran is touring Great Britain playing the music halls. Wells is clamoring for another match, and Charlie Cochran, the big London promoter, is trying to arrange a contest between Moran and another match. Should the black get back to England, Moran, however, has his eye set on the title, and knows that the shortest road is to fight his way thru the American crop of heavyweights.

NEW SPORT ARRIVES IT IS THE SKEE-BALL

NEW YORK, May 22.—A new sport has arrived in town which bids fair to be exceedingly popular. The new game is skee-ball, a variation of bowling, and the first alley for this game have been opened in Long Acre Square West. Skee-ball is played on an alley with scientifically designed bump twenty feet from the head. Sixteen feet beyond the bump in a large target containing numbered pockets. The object of the game is to roll the balls, which are about the size of a duck pin ball, into the pockets. Attached to the target is an automatic scorer which registers the score. The alleys are automatic and require no attendants. The game is highly amusing, and requires considerable skill to play with success. Nine balls constitute a game, and 200 is constituted a good score.

PETERSON LAKE MAKES ADVANCE

Closed Around Top Price of Twenty-six After Active Day

MARKET VERY ACTIVE

Forty-Five Thousand Shares Changed Hands in Two Hours' Trading

The mining market on Saturday turned much stronger with a good volume of business, some 45,000 shares changing hands in two hours' trading. The public seem to again want to enter the market as a buyer and take considerable stock. The feature of the market was the advance of Peterson Lake to 25. This stock of 375,000 on hand and has declared the regular dividend of 1 3/4 per cent. It is also stated that the finds have been made on the property and that a good offer has been made for the Gould lease. The stock looks to be the cheapest on the list, taking everything into consideration. McKinlay was strong opening at 44 and selling down to 43 1/2. Jupiter was steady, selling around 10 1/4. Vipond sold at 50. In the Cobalts, Peterson Lake was very active, opening at 24 1/2 and Timiskaming was also strong, opening at 6 and selling up to 6 1/2, closing at that figure bid. Cominas advanced to 5 on the news of a new find being made on the property. Crown Reserve was stronger at 78 bid. The market will be closed on Monday.

The explosive was to be used in naming Onondaga Creek to raise the body of 3-year-old John Wills, who was drowned two days ago. The auto was near the creek with a hundred persons near it when the explosion occurred.

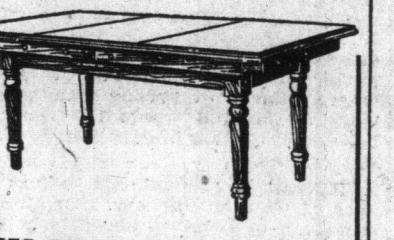
MILITARY CONTROLS RAILROADS

COLONIAL TROOPS DRIVE TURKS BACK

Allies Make Further Gains Along the Gallipoli Peninsula

LONDON, May 22.—Official announcements were made today that the French and British forces operating against the Turks on Gallipoli Peninsula gained further ground on the southern end of the peninsula. The statement reads: "The following has been received from the Mediterranean force: 'On May 19, in the southern area of Gallipoli Peninsula the French forces in conjunction with the British, made a considerable advance, and have consolidated the new position. 'Our aeroplanes dropped bombs amongst Turkish reinforcements landing from AK-Bashi Liman, and caused considerable losses. 'On the night of the 18th-19th the Turkish forces made determined attacks against the Australian and New Zealand corps which were all repulsed with heavy loss; their casualties being over 7000, of which 2000 were killed. Our losses did not exceed 500.'

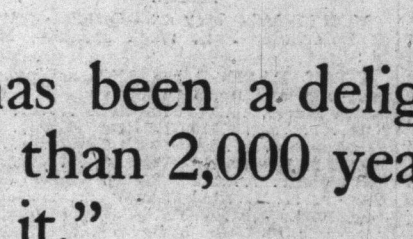

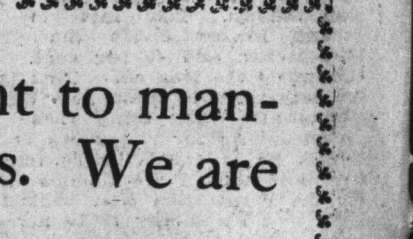
