MINUTES OF MEETING

HOME MISSION COMMITTEE
(WESTERN SECTION)
OF THE
PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA.

TORONTO, 8TH AND 9TH OCTOBER, 1878.

At Toronto, and within the Deacon's Court Room of Knox Church there, on Tuesday, the 8th day of October, 1878, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, the Home Mission Committee (Western Section) of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, met and was constituted with prayer. Rev. W. Cochran, D.D., Convener. The Committee continued in Session till 11.30 p.m., on Wednesday, 9th October.
