

Moved, in amendment, by Captain Thompson, seconded by Captain Lordly,

That all non-commissioned officers and men, after serving nine years in the Militia, be allowed the same right of entry as retired officers now have.

On the suggestion of the President, and on motion of Captain McRobbie, as an amendment to the amendment, it was

*Resolved*, That further discussion and the decision of the matter be deferred until a special meeting in May or June, the members of Council then to be notified of the nature of the question to be brought up for settlement.

Moved by Mr. Hunter, seconded by Captain Thompson,

That a committee of five (5) be selected to frame a prize list and to submit it for consideration at the special meeting.—Carried.
