Hard to Pick Leading Player in Baseball

Picking a leading baseball player in a named position is a man-sized task. To draw a comparison between certain players is overstepping the bounds of sane criticism at times. To say that Babe Ruth or Walter Johnson or Grover Alexander is the best pitcher in the game might be true, but it would be sure to start an argument over the merits of the rivals.

For instance, it can hardly be said that Arthur Fletcher or Roger Hornsby is the best shortstop in the National League merely because it is true that they lead as hitters. Neither can it be said that Maraville or Bancroft or Wortman is the best because he is a flashy, fast and accurate fielder. Each man's worth has to be considered.

From the strictly defensive standpoint it probably is permissible to announce Maraville as the premier, with Bancroft and Wortman running close behind. Everett Scott of the Red Sox, doesn't rank with Hornsby and Fletcher as a hitter, but he is a better fielder than either. However, that does not entitle him to be called the best shortstop in the game.

Comparisons of the same sort may be drawn from almost every position. Ty Cobb, of course, stands alone as an offensive playing outfielder. As a fielder he is not a Tris Speaker.

One might pick Babe Ruth as the best southpaw, but that hardly pronounces him the best pitcher.
