

ST. JOHN GIVES JOYOUS WELCOME AS NEW YEAR IS USHERED IN

Watchnight Services Held in Several Churches—Jolly Parties are Held.

There were very few citizens in St. John who were not awake at midnight on New Year's eve to greet the arrival of the New Year 1924. As the whistles, from the factories and the ships in harbor and the bells of the city pealed forth to welcome the new year, there were in progress many watch night services throughout the city at which the coming was fittingly acclaimed and in Haymarket square St. Mary's Band carried out its time-honored custom of playing out the old year and playing in the new year. James Clayton supplied cigars to the assembled crowd. The attendees at the services was above the usual and at the same time there were more citizens than usual who greeted the New Year's entry at social dances. In the Armories there were more than 1,000 gathered for the military ball, more than 400 were present at the Pythian dance in the Pythian Castle in Union street, and all of the dance hall had exceptionally large numbers of patrons. The orchestras were in so great demand that obtaining musicians was a matter of some difficulty and when musicians completed their engagements early they made the rounds of other places where dances were in progress. There were fairly large crowds in the main streets of the city at midnight but no special demonstrations were held.

The events which had been planned

for the New Year's holiday all proved great attractions. The Sunday school rallies in the morning were fortunate in having the jolliest weather. The services in the morning at the Catholic churches were attended by the customary large congregations of the faithful. As a day of sporting events, New Year's Day made a new record. Horse racing, basketball, hockey and boxing events were all included in the New Year sport programme and each event had a large following of fans. The members of the St. John Power Boat Club held open house for their friends at the club rooms at Marble Cove during the afternoon and evening and had many visitors.



A FORMER CALAIS MAN IS RECEIVER

Boston, Jan. 1.—Judge Lowell, of the Federal District Court, has appointed Guy Murchie receiver for the R. H. Long Company, and its subsidiary, the R. H. Long Motor Company. William W. Caswell, previous names by the state court as receiver for the Motor Company, will withdraw. Attorneys for Richard H. Long, of Framingham, head of the two concerns, told the court that payment of the creditors in full could be accomplished only by a receivership under a single head. The liabilities are about \$1,000,000. Receiver Murchie was a former resident of Calais, Me.

SACRIFICES LIFE TO SAVE JEWELRY

New York, Jan. 1.—Shot through the abdomen four times by the leader of a bandit trio in the Bronx, Bernard Brown, a Bronx Jeweler, yesterday sacrificed his life to save the contents of his safe.

The bandit's automobile, pursued by a fleet of taxicabs and pleasure cars whose occupants heard Brown scream as he collapsed at the entrance to his shop, escaped through a traffic jam.

New Brunswick, may, I think, reasonably contemplate the outlook for 1924 with every degree of satisfaction. With the return to more normal conditions business generally is gradually settling down and confidence is being restored. Adverse tariffs and heavy freight rates are handicaps which merchants would be glad to see removed, but there is a growing disposition to make the best of conditions as they exist and to "carry on" with increased energy.

As a result of the more extended advertising that the province has been getting of late, coupled with the excellent roads that it now possesses, there is every reason to anticipate a large increase in the tourist travel during the coming year and as this brings increased business preparations will no doubt be made to meet it.
