MORE SETBACKS FOR BOLSHIEVSKI

Park, March 7.—Russian Bolshievski forces have been driven out of Oranienbaum, a town on the southern shore of the Gulf of Finland, nineteen miles west of Petrograd, by naval units from Kronstadt, says a despatch from Viborg.

Warships have gone up the Neva river and landed contingents of sailors in Petrograd, where part of a garrison joined the revolutionary forces. The rest of the garrison is declared to have retreated toward Gatchina, thirty miles southwest, where Leon Trotsky, minister of war, and the Bolshievski high command, have headquarters.

Soviet leaders are terrified, and Lenin and Trotsky are preparing for flight, says a Reval despatch to the Matin.

Anti-Bolshievski leader Antonoff at the head of fifty thousand armed peasants is declared to be in control of the governments of Voronezh and Tambov, in Southern Russia, and it is said that this makes it impossible to revictual the northern sections of the country.

TORONTO MAN IS BEATEN; MONEY AND DIAMOND GONE

Toronto, March 7.—William A. Bell, a former hotel keeper in the west end, who now conducts a public garage, was brutally beaten by two thugs in his private garage in the rear of his home on Saturday night and robbed of \$100 in cash, a diamond tie pin valued at \$1,500 and checks to the amount of \$85.

He says they called him a name and demanded that he hand over his money and valuables, one of the two holding a revolver at his head. Bell was then beaten on the head with a revolver, also with a money wrench.

CARDINAL LOGUE APPEALS FOR TRUCE

(Canadian Press Despatch.)

Belfast, March 6.—Cardinal Logue, primate of all Ireland, in a letter to the priests of the Armagh diocese makes another powerful appeal for a truce in Ireland and suggests the forthcoming birthday of the first national apostle offer an opportune occasion for an appeal to the Almighty for the return of peace to Ireland, pointing out that St. Patrick brought peace to the country.

Deploping the disregard for human life and property shown by both sides, which he declares threatens to reduce the country to a state of desolation and ruin, Cardinal Logue especially denounces the unbecoming and unchristianlike conduct of soldiers and police in crowded thoroughfares.

"They who commit such acts know well those armed forces will blaze away, indiscriminately, killing or wounding poor innocent victims, often women, girls and children engaged in lawful occupations."

The cardinal continues: "Moreover, I think such attacks endangering the general public involve malicious acts against all mankind. Certainly all mankind should join in putting an end to them."

MORE THAN 50,000 WOMEN GOLFERS IN ENGLAND
