- WHO WAS "JACK ROBINSON?"**
- Few of those who make use of the name "Jack Robinson" in popular parlance of the figurative order are aware that the person referred to in the phrase had historical actuality. John Robinson was a political favorite of George III., and apt as member for Harford for twenty-six years, during part of which period he was secretary to the treasury. In a debate on the India bill this prominent statesman was once bitterly attacked by the witty and sharp-tongued Richard Brinsley Sheridan, who, denouncing bribery and its instigators, replied to the cries of "Name name," by pointing to Robinson on the treasury bench, exclaiming at the same time, "Yes, I could name him as soon as I could say Jack Robinson." and thus originated the saying still current.
