STUDENTS IN THEOLOGY.

I. Students who desire to enter upon a course of Theological Study in this College, other than those who have completed their course of three years in its Literary Department, must present to the Registrar, for transmission to the Senate, before the first of October, 1876.—

1. A Presbyterial certificate;
2. Evidence of having obtained the degree of B. A. at McGill University, the University of Toronto, Queen's University, Kingston, or other recognized institution;
3. A certificate of having passed at least one examination in Hebrew.

Such Students, who have not proceeded to a degree in Arts, must appear before the Board of Examiners in the College Hall on the Thursday after the first Wednesday in October, and pass satisfactory examinations in the following subjects:
