Mary's College, Halifax; St. Mary's College, Antipopular Mount Halifax; St. Francis Xavier's College, Antigonish; Mount Allison Wesleyan College, Sackville, New Brunswick; the Halifax Medical College; or the University of Toronto, are ad nitted to the First B. A. Examination without being required to have passed the MATRICULATION EXAMINATION of this University.

The Certificate of G rade A. License, issued by the Council of Public Instruction of Nova Scotia, will be accepted from Candidates for Ferr B. A. in lieu of the Cortificate of Ma-

triculation of this University.

## FIRST B. A. EXAMINATION.

The First B. A. Examination shall take place once in each year, and shall commence on the first Tuesday after the 15th July.

No Candidate shall be admitted to this Examination within one Academical yeart of the time of his passing the MATRICULATION EXAMINATION; por shall any Candidate be admitted unless he have produced a satisfactory Certificate of Good Conduct, which shall be transmitted to the Registrar at least one culendar month before the commencement of the Examination.

Bachelors of Science of this University shall be required, at the Frast B. A. Examination, to pass only in those subjects in which they have not been previously examined.
