days and Holidays not excepted, fhall be reckoned and counted to be one, and no fractions of time fhall in any fuch computation be made or allowed, it being neverthele's provided that in all cafes, in which any period allowed by any writ, Summons, Rule, Order, rule of practice or Judgment of this Court, fhall expire upon a Sunday or Holiday, fuch period fhall iplo facto fland enlarged until the then next juridical day.

Copies of judgements in appeal, to be transmitted with the record to the Court below-

Fees to be al. lowed to Counfel &cc.

Former Rules of practice refeinded, XXXIV. That a copy of each and every judgment in confequence or by virtue whereof any record in any fuit depending in this court shall be remitted to any court below, shall be annexed to such record & therewith remitted under the certificate and fignature of the clerk of this court.

XXXV. That the rules and orders of practice herein before provided for fuits in appeal, shall be deemed and taken respectively to extend to all fuits in error.

XXXVI. That the leveral fees by the ordinance made and paffed in the 20th year of the reign of our prefent fovereign Lord GEORGE the THIRD intituled" "An ordinance for the regulation and eftablishment of fees" allowed to the Counfel, attornies and Officers of the Court of Appeal for fervices by them done and performed, shall continue and be allowed to the counfel, Attornies and Officers of this Court for the like fervices when done and performed by them respectively until a table of fees shall be made and published.

XXXVII. That all rules and orders of practice heretofore made by the Provincial Court of Appeals for the late Province of Quebec and adopted by this Court and all rules and orders of practice heretofore made by this Court be and the fame and each and every of them are hereby refcinded and annulled.
