of their principall Sachims come hither to meet  
them to treat abt this affair & not to molest any  
of our people for the future in their passage to  
or from Oswego for in all the Kings Dominion  
all Roads are free & open for every body whatever  
Ordered that Jan B. Esq be allowed  
four pounds for his Journey to Oneydes.
