Ottawa, 12th July, 1926.

Dear Mr. Prime Minister,

Referring to our to-day's conversation, I beg to forward herewith "La Nation Belge" of the 13th June last, which contains a leading article under the title "Pour une politique du blé".

I have not been requested by the Belgian Government to address you on the matter referred therein, but, as there has been much talk lately about measures against imports from countries with depreciated currencies, and having in view the fact that the depreciation of the Belgian franc is due to a large extent to the Belgian imports from high currency countries, I thought that it might be of interest to know that in certain circles in Belgium it is advocated to look to other sources of supply, namely for wheat, which Belgium buys in large quantities from Canada.
