that we should be welcoming here in a capital of the New World representatives whose land goes back to the veritable cradle of western civilization.

Iraq of today is the "land between the rivers" (Mesopotamia) of history.

While Europe was still peopled by Barbarians, an advanced civilization inhabited the fertile valleys of the Euphrates and the Tigris.
